Applications must support one or more of the following: Harrogate District Strategic Partnership local priorities, the North Yorkshire Children's Trust Integrated Participation Strategy and the North Yorkshire Sustainable Communities Strategy.

Currently the Fund has £12,000 available to allocate before the end of March 2011. Funding will be granted to cover a 12 month period.
